1. (a) What is the colour used in the church during Lent? (b) Use this colour to write the list in reverse alphabetical order.
2. Choose one plural noun from the first column. Use a dictionary, or <http://dictionary.reference.com/> to research the **etymology** for this word. *Example: synagogue – this word comes to modern English from the Old French, which adapted it from the Latin*
3. (a) Write the word with the fewest number of syllables. (b) Identify what part of speech this word is.
4. (a) Which three syllable words **also** contain a consonant blend?  
(b) Which words have two syllables?
5. (a) Which list word is an adjective? (b) Write the noun derived from the same root as this word.
6. What is the adjective that belongs with \*multitude? \*cloak? \*scripture?
7. Two plural nouns in the list are antonyms for each other. (a) Write each of these words beside the appropriate **infinitive** form of the verb derived from the same base. *Example: entry – to enter* (b) Which list nouns can be used as synonyms for each other?
8. (a) What type of branches did the multitude lay down in front of Jesus?  
(b) Explain the other “handy” meaning for this word?
9. Which word has not been used in an answer yet? Write this word in your favourite colour, forty times, since there are forty days in Lent.
